Are There Countries Where I Might Not be Able to Use a Carnet?

While many countries accept Carnets, not all countries are members of the Carnet Convention. Some destinations that DO NOT ACCEPT Carnets* include:

All countries in South and Central America; the UK Virgin Islands or Tortola and Roadtown; the U.S. Virgin Islands of St. Croix, St. John and St. Thomas; and the Caribbean Islands of Anguilla, Aruba, Antigua/Barbuda, Bahamas, Barbados, Bermuda, Cayman Islands, Dominica, Grenada, Jamaica, Netherlands Antilles, St. Kitts-Nevis, St. Lucia, St. Vincent Grenadines, Trinidad & Tobago, and Turks & Caicos Islands.

**It is possible that Carnets may be accepted in these and other countries. The USCIB, however, will not guarantee their acceptance as a temporary importation*
